## **Where do we meet?**

**From I – 95:** Take Exit 80 (Rt. 543) towards Churchville. In less than a mile you'll see our sign on your left. Turn left into our driveway.

**From Bel Air –** Take 543 east towards I – 95. You are close when you see the Highlands School on your left. We are just a little further down 543 on the right. You will see our sign and will be making a right turn into our driveway.

You will be welcomed by greeters who will answer any questions you may have upon arriving. We invite you to our fellowship hall for coffee and light snacks after our 6:30 p.m. worship service.

## **We have children?**

We do not have any childcare being provided during worship services, but you are welcome to bring your children to the service. We do have a room available for you to use for your children should you need to. There is a baby changing table in the bathroom in the fellowship hall. There are monitors available for you to listen to the service as well, should you have to leave to attend to your child.

## **What is your music like?**

We sing and worship to a diverse mix of music, from classic hymns in a contemporary style to modern praise and worship songs. We worship to music from artists of many different styles and backgrounds.

## **What should I wear?**

You will find everything from casual, business casual to the occasional dress or suit. Please wear whatever makes you feel comfortable. Come as you are.

## **Am I expected to put money in the offering?**

If you are visiting with us, you are our guest and we do not expect you to place any money in the offering. You are welcome to give if you would like, but we only really want to know who you are!
